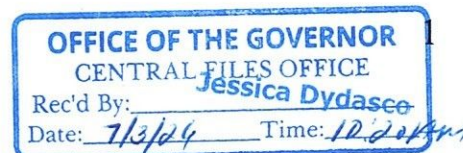

**AN ACT TO REALLOCATE UNEXPENDED
EMERGENCY FUNDS FROM THE TYPHOON *SINLAKE*
APPROPRIATION TO *I MAGA'HÁGAN GUÁHAN* FOR
EMERGENCY RESPONSE TO TROPICAL
DEPRESSION 09W (BAVI).**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Emergency Expenses. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, and in addition to existing authorities under 5 GCA §22402 and Public Law 38-60, any unexpended balance of the Twenty-Five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000) previously appropriated for emergency response and recovery related to Tropical Storm *Sinlaku* shall remain available for obligation and expenditure by *I*



1 *Maga'hågan Guåhan* for emergency response, mitigation, and recovery activities
2 associated with Tropical Depression 09W, including any escalation into a tropical
3 storm or typhoon. Such expenses include, but are not limited to, costs related to
4 safety and security; food, water, and sheltering; health and medical services; energy;
5 communications; transportation; and hazardous materials. Individual Assistance is
6 authorized under this Section, supported by survey and damage assessment data. *I*
7 *Maga'håga* shall disburse Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) to each
8 Mayor's Office, who may utilize such monies for the purposes identified above.
9 Mayors shall report all expenditures within forty-five (45) days of expenditure. *I*
10 *Maga'håga* shall disburse Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) from
11 the funds appropriated herein to each Guam Department of Education School that is
12 activated as a shelter for residents. GDOE may utilize such monies for the purposes
13 identified above. The Superintendent of GDOE shall report all expenditure of funds
14 provided herein to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the Public Auditor within forty-five
15 (45) days of expenditure. *I Maga'håga* shall disburse One Hundred Thousand
16 Dollars (\$100,000) from the funds appropriated herein to the Mayor's Council of
17 Guam for administrative costs. The Executive Director of the Mayor's Council shall
18 report all expenditure of funds provided herein to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
19 Public Auditor within forty-five (45) days of expenditure. *I Maga'håga* shall provide
20 a written report of all expenditures under this Section, including those expended by
21 the Mayors, to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the Public Auditor within sixty (60) days
22 of initial disbursement and every thirty (30) days thereafter.

23 **Section 2.** *I Maga'håga* shall make the disbursements herein in the
24 following order: first, to the Mayoral Offices; second, to the Mayor's Council of
25 Guam; and third, to each Guam Department of Education School activated as a
26 shelter. Any unexpended funds appropriated to the Mayoral Offices, the Mayor's

1 Council of Guam or to a Guam Department of Education School shelter shall revert
2 to the Rainy Day Fund.

3 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective immediately.
