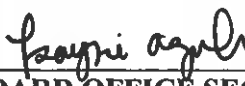

Guam comes up short in girls softball, settles for 2nd place

Team Guam represented well at the 2026 Little League Asia Pacific Senior Softball Tournament in Indonesia, finishing in 2nd place.

Guam took care of Indonesia and Thailand in competitive matchups, but the team from the Philippines (Bulacan Dreamers) were just too much for the four-team field.

Bulacan dominated the field, averaging a margin of victory of 22-0 and not giving up a hit! They beat Guam by identical 21-0 scores in both pool play and in the championship game on Monday.

Guam beat Indonesia and Thailand

in pool play and then doubled up on Indonesia in the semis 14-7.

The highlight of the tournament came on Sunday when Kiersten Fernandez pitched a complete game with 4 strikeouts and also went 4-5 with 1 RBI on Father's Day honoring her dad, Coach Kin Fernandez.

Coach Kin was the manager of the team and was supposed to lead this team. Unfortunately, he suddenly passed away on May 9. He had just finalized the team roster the night before his passing.

because, as a coach, he always wanted to "share the greatness of baseball" in Japan and overseas.

"I came here to teach today's kids they can succeed and become professional players, too, [and] also teach Japanese etiquette and manners. It is really enjoyable," Akiyoshi said.

Akiyoshi said today's kids are "still small and can't throw 100 mph yet," so it is important to teach them the fundamentals when they are young. He said laying the foundation is crucial to them throwing faster and stronger when they are older.

"The most important thing is to have fun. Also, it is a team sport, so I hope they learn to listen to each other," Akiyoshi said.

Better chance of going pro'

Despite not speaking the same language, Akiyoshi and Tashiro said they were having fun with the kids and communicating through gestures and demonstrating skills.

There were also kids who spoke Japanese that helped interpret the coaches' instruction, according to Junior Seman, 10, from Saipan.

Other than local kids, the camp also invited young players from the CNMI

side each other.

Seman said he has been playing since he was six years old as a shortstop and second baseman.

"I like making new friends when playing on different teams. This is my second time. I saw [Tashiro and Akiyoshi] last year, so I like learning new ways to throw the ball and hitting. If they keep coming, I feel like I have a better chance of going pro," Seman said.

Tatsunari Kono, 13, from Tokyo, interpreted for Tashiro.

Tashiro wants kids to be humble and enjoy the sport, especially to make new friends and connections.

"Even though the message isn't clear, he uses

the phrases and words he knows and tries to rephrase it so kids can understand. He also shows it through his actions and shows examples, and I [help] translate," Kono said.

Keeping the sport alive

Tashiro added that the population of people who play baseball in Japan is decreasing. He said the popularity of Japan's Shohei Ohtani, who plays for the LA Dodgers in Major League Baseball, "holds off the rate of decrease by a bit, but the population is still decreasing a bit."

Tashiro and Kono told Pacific Daily News that people are not allowed to use local parks to play base-

ball in Japan. They want to bring back the baseball population, and they want schools to "get know baseball more in PE," Kono added.

"[Tashiro] believes that things we do outside of baseball, such as perseverance, are important. He wants more people, not only in Japan but other countries, to meet up with

friends and families to play baseball together, especially on weekends or any open day," Kono said.
