**RELATIVE TO DECLARING THE DAY BEFORE
LIBERATION DAY A HOLIDAY**

WHEREAS, the liberation of Guam by United States Armed Forces on July 21, 1944, is one of the most significant events in the history of Guam; and

WHEREAS, the community-wide celebration commemorating our liberation is an important annual event that brings our people together to honor those who secured our island's freedom and to celebrate Guam's enduring spirit; and

WHEREAS, declaring the day preceding Liberation Day as a Government of Guam holiday will provide the people of Guam with additional time to commemorate the liberation of our island, reflect upon the sacrifices made for the freedom of our community, and celebrate the resilience and unity demonstrated by our people through hardships caused by war and natural disasters.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LOURDES A. LEON GUERRERO, *I Maga'hågan Guåhan*, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, and the laws of Guam and the United States, do hereby order as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to 1 GCA § 1000(c), Monday, July 20, 2026, is hereby declared a holiday for employees of the Government of Guam.

SECTION 2. All executive departments and agencies of the Government of Guam shall be closed and their employees excused from duty on July 20, 2026, except as provided in Section 3 of this Order.

SECTION 3. The heads of executive departments and agencies may determine that certain offices, facilities, or parts thereof must remain open and that certain employees must report for duty on July 20, 2026, to meet essential public needs.

SECTION 4. July 20, 2026, shall be administered in accordance with the Department of Administration Personnel Rules and Regulations promulgated by Executive Order No. 96-24, as amended, with respect to employee pay and leave.
