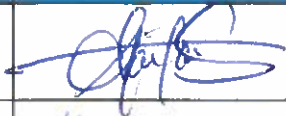

to honor before every match.

"I pray to my grandma Trini before my fights. She is always there for me. It also makes me feel closer to my ancestors. I have so much support from others who are from the island," she said.

Tāsi is named after her grandmother Trinidad Cruz Reyes from Hāgat. Tāsi's full name is Tāsi-Trinidad Marley Boots.

Women's nationals

Just last week, Tāsi went 8-3 in the USA Wrestling Women's National Duals as part of Team Oregon. It is the premier girls-only team wrestling tournament in the country, featuring state all-star teams

competing in freestyle and Greco-Roman styles. The event is a massive recruiting showcase for college coaches, as women's collegiate wrestling continues to grow rapidly.

Team Oregon went on to win the tournament as Tāsi's wins helped the cause. All her wins came via pins in less than a minute.

The busy part of her competition season is over. The one competition she has left is the Beach Wrestling State Championships in August on the Oregon Coast. It will be her first time competing at such an event, but mostly she wants to spend the summer putting more on muscle and working her technique.

The family thanks Tāsi's coaches Natasha Umemo-to and Austin and Jessica Lister, as well Alex Castro and Most Hated for sponsoring her.

Here are 5 ways to spend less on running

50 million Americans who are runners, you might have the impression that the sport is basically free. You have a T-shirt, you have shorts, you have sneakers, and out the door you go. Right?

Let Andrew Huynh disabuse you of that notion. The financial planner from Tolland, Connecticut, is an “avid” runner, and he wants you to know: Being a serious runner is most definitely not free.

“The costs can add up quickly once you actually get started,” Huynh tells Current, a consumer fintech banking platform. “I’ve seen many people underestimate the investment before even registering for a race, including shoes, nutrition, recovery tools, gym memberships, and training gear.”

Total it all up, and the costs can get pretty eye-popping. According to a survey from Running USA, runners spent an average of \$1,748 in the previous year on the sport.

Since many runners right now are aiming toward races in the fall (longer distances typically take a few months of training), now is the perfect time to start planning things out. Some key advice, to get a handle on costs before they start to run away from you:

Plan early, plan often.

There are a host of reasons why preparing as early as possible will save you a significant amount of money. First, most races offer early discounts on entries, which ramp up over time as you get closer to the start date. Second, many races book hotel blocks for participants at special rates, which, for popular events, get booked up quickly.

One tip: Some specialty operators, like Marathon Tours & Travel, offer package deals

that include flights, hotels, and guaranteed entries into hard-to-get races.

Don't go crazy on

apparel.

The fancy brands of the world won't want to hear this, but there's no reason to go

overboard on pricey athletic wear. You do need synthetic materials, especially socks — cotton chafes, as every runner knows — but the reality is that entries in most races come with giveaways, such as tops or shorts. As a result, you can assemble a “free” wardrobe in a pretty short order.

One place to splurge: Shoes.

You should absolutely not skimp on running shoes by buying used gear, even though it may be tempting to do so. The reasons are both performance and injury related: Individual gaits require certain types of shoes, with particular cushioning.

	1. Reynaldo Tingson S. Manibusan confirmed that Zoom meeting links and reminders had been provided to the relevant parties. The Board then discussed concerns regarding Stay Fresh Academy in light of legal guidance received from the Attorney General's Office. A. Taitano-Sablan expressed agreement with the guidance and recommended pursuing disciplinary action against the school, as well as opening an investigation into the establishment and the licensed instructors who continued operating the school and accepting students during the period in which the establishment license had lapsed. M. Tiong concurred with the recommendation, citing the Board's obligation to address potential violations related to unlicensed practice and to hold the school accountable for operating with an expired license. It was noted that further investigation would be necessary to fully evaluate the matter and determine the appropriate course of action. A. Taitano-Sablan also raised concerns regarding the impact on students who enrolled and attended classes while the school was operating without a valid establishment license. Discussion focused on the time, effort, and financial resources invested by students pursuing careers through the program, as well as the challenges faced by those attempting to transfer to other schools. Consideration was given to the possibility of approving or certifying completed instructional hours so that affected students could transfer those hours to another approved program and continue their education. A. Taitano-Sablan requested a motion to pursue disciplinary action and open a formal investigation into Stay Fresh Academy and all licensed instructors affiliated with the school during the relevant period. During discussion, R. Santos expressed concern regarding an instructor formerly associated with Stay Fresh Academy who was now teaching at another school and sought clarification on how the Board intended to address the matter while ensuring that current and prospective students received the education for which they were paying. In response, A. Taitano-Sablan emphasized that no formal decisions regarding licensure or disciplinary action would be made until the investigation process was completed. It was noted that the Board had already identified evidence warranting further review, but that a thorough investigation was necessary to ensure that any disciplinary decisions would be informed and supported by the facts. R. Santos acknowledged the explanation and reiterated concern for the students' educational interests. A. Taitano-Sablan agreed and stressed the importance of initiating the investigation to protect students and prevent similar situations from occurring in the future. Blended/Online Theory Instruction It was noted that programs currently in the process of accreditation are still expected to provide appropriate in-class instruction and practical training to ensure students are fully aware of the educational offerings prior to the implementation of blended or online theory components. Support was expressed for maintaining structured, contact-hour-based education standards, particularly given the regulatory requirements of the profession. Further discussion emphasized that, although technology has enabled alternative learning formats, programs must continue to meet required contact-hour standards through either in-person instruction or, verifiable online instruction in which student attendance can be properly documented. It was noted that during the COVID, schools successfully adapted by requiring real-time participation through virtual platforms with verified attendance, which was accepted as meeting contact-hour requirements.
