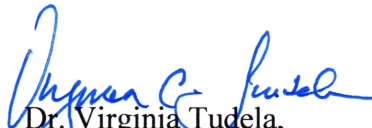

ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE IN PRACTICAL NURSING

The Associate of Science in Practical Nursing 2024-2025 cohort, which graduated on May 8, 2025, currently has an 81% first-write pass rate, with 22 of 27 students passing the NCLEX-PN exam on their first attempt. Currently, five students have yet to take the exam. The Nursing & Allied Health Department has made multiple efforts to reach out to these students to explore effective strategies to assist them in preparing for and successfully passing the exam.

The 2025-2026 ASPN cohort successfully concluded their second semester on May 6, 2026. During this quarter, eighteen students completed a total of 115 hours of clinical practice for NU220 Adult Medical Surgical Nursing at Guam Memorial Hospital's Medical Surgical Unit. The clinical instructors for this component were Carlie Webb and Hye Won Choi.

While there were no classes in session during the summer semester of 2026, students have begun utilizing their 360-day UWorld subscription. This online study resource includes NCLEX practice tests that provide detailed explanations focused on clinical judgment and patient care decisions, as well as a self-assessment feature to gauge exam readiness. As students prepare for their final semester in the fall of 2026, this tool will be instrumental in their preparation for the NCLEX-PN exam upon graduation.

The Nursing & Allied Health Department is now accepting applications for the 2027 Practical Nursing cohort. The application period will remain open until September 25, 2026, with evaluations to follow, and notifications on selection status projected to be completed by October 14, 2026. The next ASPN cohort is expected to start in the 2027 spring semester. Students who are interested in the Associate of Science in Practical Nursing are highly encouraged to seek guidance from the Nursing & Allied Health Department.

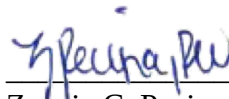
The Nursing and Allied Health Department continues to seek qualified adjunct faculty to instruct the laboratory and clinical components of NU-level courses required for the program.
