Dr. Berg further noted that new appointees would be sought through the Governor's Office and that Dr. Alford's name had been submitted for appointment, although no action had yet been taken. An inquiry would be made to the Chair of the Healthcare Committee regarding the status of her appointment process.			
V.	HPLO Administrator's Report	No report was presented. B. Sablan noted that efforts would continue to address the current Board vacancies so that the Board could be filled and proceed with elections.	HPLO		No Report
VI.	Chairperson's Report	Dr. Berg reported that there were no significant updates but encouraged Board members to identify qualified candidates to fill the current Board vacancies. Potential public member candidates were suggested to include members or former members of the clergy, retired healthcare administrators, attorneys, former university professors, and former university administrators with experience serving on boards. Dr. Berg also encouraged the identification of qualified physician candidates and emphasized that collaborative efforts among Board members could help recruit suitable individuals. Dr. Berg requested that the Board's eligibility requirements for appointment, including the requirement that physician members be licensed and actively practicing on Guam for at least five years, be distributed to assist with the recruitment process. Additionally, Dr. Berg requested that information regarding the upcoming Federation of State Medical Boards meeting in Oklahoma City, including the meeting dates and hotel information, be circulated to Board members and encouraged attendance if possible. Dr. Eusebio had a question regarding Public Law 38-107, noting that the Board is required to develop its own policies and SOP before the law can be fully implemented. He further noted that applicants are awaiting the completion of these procedures and that, GMH is preparing to present their SOP to the Credentials Committee, further progress is dependent upon the Board adopting its corresponding policies and procedures. Dr. Berg stated that the Board had previously been assured that funding would be provided for administrative support to assist with implementation of the program but acknowledged that the lack of such funding should not delay the adoption of the necessary rules and regulations. Dr. Berg proposed collaborating with Dr. Eusebio to review existing procedures and develop complementary policies that would ensure a coordinated and efficient implementation process. Dr. Berg further suggested scheduling a meeting to begin the review process, requested that the existing procedures be shared for evaluation, and emphasized that the Board and the related entities should work jointly, recognizing that their respective roles are closely interconnected. Dr. Eusebio agreed and noted that the Board's policies could largely reference the law, as the law already establishes the applicable requirements.	Dr. Berg		Noted

		The Board was advised that formal adoption of the policies was the primary action needed before implementation could proceed. Dr. Berg agreed that the Board could adopt the necessary rules to begin implementation and revise them as needed in the future. The Chair emphasized that the absence of formally adopted rules should not delay the acceptance of the initial applicants and committed to moving the process forward while requesting assistance in ensuring that the matter remained a priority Dr. Galgo asked a question regarding the status of applicants associated with the IT program established under the referenced public law. He requested clarification on whether any interested applicants had submitted applications to date. Dr. Berg stated that individuals had expressed interest in the program and were being directed to Dr. Eusebio for initial review and acceptance. It was explained that physician applicants would first need to be accepted before their application packages and proposed submissions could be presented to the Board. Dr. Berg reiterated that the Board must establish its rules and regulations and committed to working with Dr. Eusebio to develop policies and procedures consistent with the requirements outlined in the law. Dr. Berg noted that the law provides the framework for the Board's initial rules and that revisions could be made as necessary during implementation. It was further discussed that GMH and the GBME are the two primary government entities involved and should collaborate to create coordinated policies and procedures that clearly define the responsibilities of each organization. Dr. Berg expressed the goal of completing the development of these rules and regulations by the next Board meeting. Dr. Berg asked whether there were any additional questions from the Board. After receiving no further inquiries, Dr. Berg proceeded with the next item on the agenda.

The Board discussed the benefit of having an available qualified reviewer on island rather than seeking an independent contractor from off island. Dr. Berg stated that efforts were underway to finalize the arrangement and expressed hope that the matter could be resolved by the end of the following month. Dr. Berg also noted that both parties will have a CME that will address the relevant issue, as neither party specializes in pediatric ophthalmology and such specialists are not currently available on Guam. Dr. Berg further highlighted that this collaboration could help establish a stronger professional relationship between USC and Guam due to USC's pediatric ophthalmology resources and existing connection with the island. Additionally, Dr. Berg reported plans to seek input from one of the most prominent specialists in congenital or pediatric-onset cataracts for further assistance with the case. Guam started the second set on serve but committed an early service error, allowing American Samoa to get on the board first.

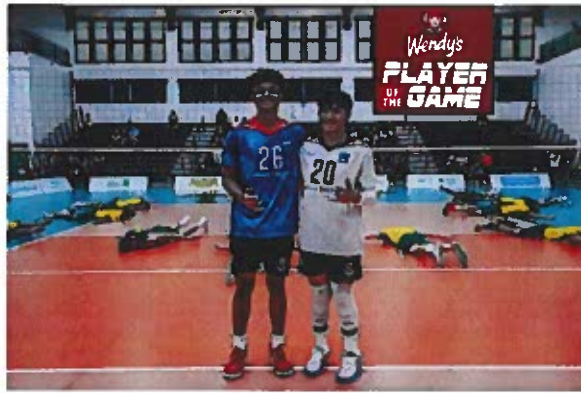

American Samoa fought back to tie the set at 14-14, fueled by Muliaga's serving run and consistent attacking. Guam, however, answered with a 4-point run to take an 18-14 lead, forcing another timeout from American Samoa.

Late in the set, Matthew Dimapan came in at setter and helped maintain Guam's offensive rhythm. Guam remained in control the rest of the way, capitalizing on an American Samoa service error to secure the second set 25-19 and take a 2-0 lead in the match.

Set 3

Looking to close out the match, Guam battled American Samoa through a tightly contested third set.

Guam held a narrow 13-10 lead, forcing American Samoa to use a timeout as both teams traded kills and shut-down blocks in a fast-paced exchange.

American Samoa refused to back down, with Muliaga recording numerous kills to keep his team within striking distance. The momentum shifted briefly as American Samoa took a 16-15 lead, forcing Guam to call a timeout. However, an American Samoa service error allowed Guam to quickly level the score at 16-16 and regain its composure.

From there, Guam went on a decisive run, turning a close battle into a commanding 21-18 advantage. With momentum fully on its side, Guam stayed aggressive on both ends of the court before Ethan Alvarez delivered the final kill to seal the 25-20 third-set, securing the straight-set victory over American Samoa.

dominant for the men from Down Under as Aubrey, Caden Day and Changmin Lee all got into the range to fire away. Mid set, the Aussies threw a block party as Willis, Caleb Lockington

and Hunter Hopkins all put defensive walls that Guam couldn't penetrate. The highlight for Guam was Taitano's three kills that delighted the crowd.

Both teams emptied their benches in the third set as the inevitable was just a matter of time.

"Australia is a very practiced, disciplined team," Guam head coach Steve Pangelinan said. "If I'm not mistaken, this is the very first time Guam has ever played them in an international tournament."

"As far as the game tonight, although we lost, I was very happy that we were able to get many kills in that first set, especially with our middle attack. In the sets to follow, Australia made sure to serve tough at us, which made it harder to run our offense. Taking all this into consideration, I think our guys played competitively against Australia, but they were just too tough tonight."

Australia had 37 kills, led by Audrey and Willis with seven each. Guam had 18 kills with Taitano and Ezekiel Sablan having five apiece. The Aussies had 10 blocks for points. Guam had two.

For the Aussies, they are still finding their chemistry as a team, since they had only a 3-day camp prior to this tournament.

"It's a little bit rough because majority of our team came from different states in Australia," team captain Max Senica said. "But a lot of us have played with each other in some capacity in the past year, so we're already prepared in that regard."

"It's obviously a great feeling, but the job is not done. We have one more big one tomorrow (Sunday), and that's the only one that matters for us. If we stick to what we need to do and play at our best level, we'll take care of business tomorrow."

"Obviously, we came here to perform for our country," said Aaron Alsop, assistant coach. "We have expectations to play in the gold medal game and we've done that. We have to recover tonight and review New Caledonia. We think we match up with them really well. They guys are healthy and we've had a great week in preparation for tomorrow. This is the one that we want."

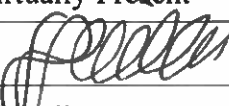
