Salas-Matanane. The draft incorporated input from G. Woodard regarding APRN provisions, recommendations from Dr. Varghese on educational matters, and additional contributions addressing community, bedside, and hospital nursing. He further reported that the draft included language necessary for participation in the NLC, with the applicable NLC rules and regulations to be attached following coordination with Mr. Jim Puente. Additional revisions included updates to recognize ADN and LPN programs, the potential inclusion of the University of Guam's Master of Science in Nursing program, APRN-related provisions, and other comprehensive regulatory changes. The Board was also advised that proposed fee increases of approximately 10% to 20% would be included, with the final estimated amounts to be provided upon completion of the draft. G. Ramos acknowledged the progress and stated that the Board would await receipt of the finalized draft. M. Ramos requested that the revised draft be distributed with all newly added provisions highlighted in a different color, such as red, to clearly distinguish the revisions and facilitate the Board's review. n helping Guam separate from the Cook Islands, consistently distributing the ball to multiple hitters and keeping the opposing defense guessing. Piper, Lea Aromin, Kaelia Borja, and Keivann Susuico all contributed key attacks during Guam's scoring run.

Cook Islands answered behind the efforts of E. Aka-

va-Akaruru, T. Tamangaro, T. Tangirere, T. Puna, and S. Solomona, but Guam held off a late push before Piper delivered the final kill to secure the second set, 25-16, and a commanding 2-0 set lead.

Set 3

Coming closer to the possibility of facing a loss, the Cook Islands came out with renewed energy in the third set.

Guam struggled to find their groove opening in set three as Cook Islands controlled the pace with aggressive attacking and

disciplined defense. Aka-va-Akaruru became the focal point of the visitors' surge, dominating at the net with both powerful spikes and timely blocks – seeming to be the cause of the Guam athletes' increasingly difficult time with execution during this set.

Although Guam began to regain some offensive momentum midway through the set and Piper strengthened the team's defensive effort, the hosts were unable to overcome their slow start. Borja provided several of Guam's strongest attacks during the set, but Cook Islands maintained control to claim a 25-17 victory and extend the match.

Set 4

Guam quickly respond-

ed in the fourth set with its strongest performance of the afternoon.

Piper once again took command offensively, leading an explosive attack that prevented Cook Islands from building any momentum. On the opposite side of the net, Tangirere and Solomona continued to battle for Cook Islands, while setter E. Parkinson worked to keep the offense organized despite limited support.

The Guam athletes' defense also cleaned up to close out the match, complementing their more efficient attacks, allowing the hosts to steadily pull away before sealing the set 25-10 to secure their four-set victory.

Piper and Camacho

Player of the Game team captain Faith Piper alongside her setter Manea Camacho credited both teams for bringing energy to the opening day of competition.

"It was a great game," Piper said. "We came out strong. The other island—Cook Islands—also came out strong. They came out swinging. They were great, well-rounded—they got us a couple times, but we answered back, and that's really all that matters."

"We came in pumped, ready for this first game, and Cook Islands was, too," Camacho said. "It was really nice to see how all the islands came out. When we came onto that third set, they really brought it, and it showed us how to bounce back."

Both players pointed out Guam's preparation for helping the team overcome their opponents. Especially in needing to get back up after the momentum shift in the third set.

"Practices leading up to Oceania ... we were kind of honing in on our skills—doing the same skills that we've been doing—same drills—kind of just trying to perfect the basics, the foundations," Piper said. "Of course, we still have a lot of improving

to do, but that's pretty much what we've been doing leading up to this."

"We try to stay pretty consistent with practice whether that be the warmups and just the simple normal stuff," Camacho said. "[The Guam girls] are really connected really fast and it was really nice to do what we have practiced in practice in the real game."

Looking ahead to Guam's next match of the tournament against Marshall Islands, both players expressed confidence while remaining focused.

"I'm pumped! We played really, really well today against a great team," Piper said. "Both [the male and female] Guam teams got it up, so I'm excited...Feeling good, feeling good."

"Super-duper excited," Camacho added. "Just wanting to stay humble, of course."

Piper and Camacho also reflected on the atmosphere surrounding the opening day of competition.

"Shoutout to all the team that came out. Everyone is so friendly. We were literally taking pictures with everybody outside right before we played, so it's great and it's fun watching competitive volleyball, too."

"Yeah, again, it's really nice to all come together," Camacho said.

Next up for Guam women's team

Guam will look to carry its opening victory into its next match against the Marshall Islands on Wednesday Aug. 5, at 1:30 p.m.
