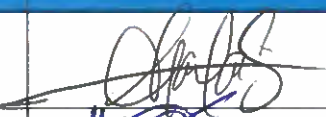

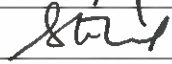

Registration open for the 6th Annual Greg D. Perez International Sportfishing Derby

The Greg D. Perez Sportfishing Foundation announces that registration is now open for the 6th Annual Greg D. Perez International Sportfishing Derby, presented by Budweiser with Guam Visitors Bureau serving as the event's Supporting Partner.

Taking place Aug. 22 to 23 from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. each day, the two-day tournament will launch from both the Gregorio D. Perez Marina in Hagåtña and the Agat Marina, bringing together Guam's sportfishing community for one of the island's premier offshore fishing events, according to a press release.

Hosted by the Greg D. Perez

Sportfishing Foundation to honor the extraordinary legacy of legendary Guam fisherman Gregorio "Greg" D. Perez, the derby celebrates Guam's rich maritime heritage while promoting responsible sportfishing, marine conservation, youth education, and community engagement. Through its programs and annual events, the Foundation is committed to preserving Guam's fishing traditions, protecting its marine resources, and inspiring the next generation of anglers and ocean stewards.

Tournament participants will compete for cash prizes across five species categories:

- Marlin
- Mahi Mahi

- Yellowfin tuna
- Wahoo
- Bonita

Adding to the excitement is the tournament's signature challenge — a \$50,000 cash prize awarded if a marlin caught during the derby surpasses Greg D. Perez's legendary world-record 1,153-pound Pacific Blue Marlin, a record that has stood as one of Guam's greatest sporting achievements and remains an enduring symbol of the island's sportfishing legacy.

Registration is now open online at www.gregdperezfoundation.org. Entry fees are \$250 for a captain and one angler, with additional anglers \$75 each.

Every registered boat will also receive complimentary ice and a fuel card, generously provided by Matson and IP&E, helping participants prepare for an exciting weekend on the water.

An important Captain's Meeting will be held on Thursday, Aug. 20, at the Guam Fishermen's Co-op. Registration opens at 5:30 p.m., followed by the mandatory captain's briefing, where teams will receive tournament information, review official rules, and complete final registration requirements.

The celebration concludes with the Awards Banquet at Hotel Nikko Guam on Monday, Aug. 24, beginning at 6 p.m., where tournament champions and special award recipients will be recognized.

dominant for the men from Down Under as Aubrey, Caden Day and Changmin Lee all got into the range to fire away. Mid set, the Aussies threw a block party as Willis, Caleb Lockington

and Hunter Hopkins all put defensive walls that Guam couldn't penetrate. The highlight for Guam was Taitano's three kills that delighted the crowd.

Both teams emptied their benches in the third set as the inevitable was just a matter of time.

"Australia is a very practiced, disciplined team," Guam head coach Steve Pangelinan said. "If I'm not mistaken, this is the very first time Guam has ever played them in an international tournament."

"As far as the game tonight, although we lost, I was very happy that we were able to get many kills in that first set, especially with our middle attack. In the sets to follow, Australia made sure to serve tough at us, which made it harder to run our offense. Taking all this into consideration, I think our guys played competitively against Australia, but they were just too tough tonight."

Australia had 37 kills, led by Audrey and Willis with seven each. Guam had 18 kills with Taitano and Ezekiel Sablan having five apiece. The Aussies had 10 blocks for points. Guam had two.

For the Aussies, they are still finding their chemistry as a team, since they had only a 3-day camp prior to this tournament.

"It's a little bit rough because majority of our team came from different states in Australia," team captain Max Senica said. "But a lot of us have played with each other in some capacity in the past year, so we're already prepared in that regard."

"It's obviously a great feeling, but the job is not done. We have one more big one tomorrow (Sunday), and that's the only one that matters for us. If we stick to what we need to do and play at our best level, we'll take care of business tomorrow."

"Obviously, we came here to perform for our country," said Aaron Alsop, assistant coach. "We have expectations to play in the gold medal game and we've done that. We have to recover tonight and review New Caledonia. We think we match up with them really well. They guys are healthy and we've had a great week in preparation for tomorrow. This is the one that we want."

The Cowboys moved the chains in the first quarter and entered the red zone, looking to score early. The Eagles' got a huge stop in the end zone of an interception by Talan Babauta.

The Cowboys broke the tie in the second period with a 39-yard touchdown pass from quarterback Ezekiel-Rey Maysho to Cruz. Maysho's successful kick put the Cowboys up 8-0. Cruz was listed under an apprentice application during the June meeting even though the application had already been approved in May, and that the matter should have been identified as a rescission during the June meeting. Cruz had not received a rescission notice and had only received a denial of application, despite the application having already been approved. A. Taitano-Sablan clarified that because the rescission was placed on the agenda for the current meeting, the official rescission notice would be issued following the Board's approval of the rescission action during the meeting. She stated that C. Cruz would receive an email notification after the meeting informing her that the Board voted on and approved the rescission. T. Degracia questioned whether C. Cruz would be required to submit an additional appeal following the rescission process. She expressed concern that the only notice received by C. Cruz was a denial of an application that had already been approved and questioned the process of revisiting the rescission action from the June meeting on the July agenda. The representative further stated that the original notice and appeal request were based on the denial of an already approved application. A. Taitano-Sablan stated that C. Cruz had already submitted the appeal and reiterated that it is difficult for the Board to discuss an applicant's matter in detail without the applicant being present. T. Degracia stated that C. Cruz is currently an apprentice and not an applicant, as her application had already been approved. She expressed concern that the Board's adverse

		action was being taken after the approval of her application and stated that there is an established procedure that must be followed when taking adverse action against an approved apprentice. She questioned again the use of a previous establishment violation as the basis for the action, emphasizing that the violation had been corrected and closed. The representative stated that the Board was bringing up an old, resolved establishment violation toward an approved apprentice in an effort to deny her status. A. Taitano-Sablan clarified that the apprentice permit was never issued to C. Cruz, and therefore she was not considered an apprentice, she does not have an apprentice permit on her person. T. Degracia stated that the May meeting minutes reflected that C. Cruz had been approved and argued that the permit itself was only the required document confirming the approval, noting that C. Cruz had received an email notification indicating approval of her apprenticeship application and examination. A. Taitano-Sablan reiterated that it was difficult to discuss the matter in detail with C. Cruz not being present, as there were questions that needed to be addressed directly with her. T. Degracia expressed concerns that no communication had been received from the Board regarding C. Cruz’s matter, including information about scheduling a hearing or further steps in the appeal process. A. Taitano-Sablan clarified that the Board had received the appeal request, which was why the matter was placed on the agenda. T. Degracia disputed this, stating that the item appeared on the agenda before the appeal request was submitted. A. Taitano-Sablan explained that the appeal request had been submitted only a few days prior and that the Board had previously communicated with C. Cruz regarding her ability to request an appeal. She further explained that the matter was placed on the agenda in advance due to the time-sensitive nature of the appeal process and to prevent unnecessary delays that could have required C. Cruz to wait until August or September. T. Degracia acknowledged the explanation and noted that the appeal was subject to a 30-day timeframe, it was June 23 when C. Cruz received the notice.

		A. Taitano-Sablan reiterated that C. Cruz needs to appear before the Board for the appeal hearing and clarified that T. Degracia is more than welcome to accompany and assist her during the process. A. Taitano-Sablan explained that certain questions must be addressed directly to C. Cruz and that she must respond directly to the Board. She further stated that, now that the appeal request had been received, the Board could begin the process of scheduling the appeal hearing. T. Degracia acknowledged the clarification and expressed appreciation for the information provided. She further clarified that the appeal also involves the establishment, as the basis for the action against C. Cruz relates to an establishment violation. A. Taitano-Sablan clarified that although the establishment permit matter was included with C. Cruz's appeal submission, the appeal regarding C. Cruz's apprentice permit rescission and the establishment's appeal would be considered separate matters. She explained that the two matters would require separate hearings, with one hearing addressing C. Cruz's apprentice permit rescission and another addressing the establishment owner's appeal. After consultation with the administrator, A. Taitano-Sablan clarified that a separate appeal submission from the establishment was not required and that the combined appeal submission could remain as filed. She further stated that any assistance provided by T. Degracia, as the establishment owner, during C. Cruz's appeal hearing would be limited to the matters identified in C. Cruz's appeal. T. Degracia thanked the Board and acknowledged and expressed understanding of the clarification.
