		A. Personal Interviews The Board provided an overview of the Guam dental licensure examination process to the two applicants eligible to take the upcoming examination. The Board explained that applicants must first successfully complete the jurisprudence examination, which covers Guam laws, rules, and regulations governing the practice of dentistry, before they are eligible to take the two-day clinical examination. Applicants were advised that the jurisprudence examination may be scheduled at the Board office at any time prior to the clinical examination. The Board explained that the first day of the clinical examination begins with a crown preparation exercise on a typodont. Applicants are required to provide their own typodont, select an appropriate tooth for preparation, and ensure that the selected tooth has proper occlusion and proximal contacts before beginning the procedure. The Board will evaluate the selected tooth before authorizing applicants to proceed with the crown preparation. Upon completion, the	GBED		Noted

		preparation will be assessed to ensure it meets acceptable clinical standards, including proper tooth preparation, sound adjacent teeth, and overall quality. Following approval of the crown preparation, applicants are required to complete the associated laboratory procedures, including taking impressions, pouring and trimming the model, identifying crown margins, waxing the crown, mounting the wax pattern, and placing it into a casting ring for evaluation. After the casting ring is reviewed, applicants will complete the investment process before submitting the typodont and laboratory work for inspection. The Board explained that applicants will then retain their laboratory materials and complete the fabrication of the crown outside of the examination in preparation for the second day of the clinical examination. The Board explained that the second component of the first examination day consists of an oral diagnosis exercise in which applicants will receive a patient case that includes radiographs, medical and dental histories, and study models. Applicants are required to develop and submit a comprehensive written treatment plan that addresses the patient's diagnoses, recommended restorations, referrals when appropriate, and treatment options at varying levels of care. The completed treatment plan must be submitted by the end of the first examination day, although applicants were encouraged to complete the assignment as early as possible. The Board further explained that applicants are required to complete and present the laboratory portion of the crown preparation exercise by submitting the completed models, wax

		pattern, and invested casting ring for evaluation before taking the remaining laboratory materials to complete fabrication of the crown outside of the examination in preparation for the second day. Applicants were advised to determine in advance whether they would fabricate the crown themselves or arrange for a dental laboratory to complete the work. The Board informed applicants that the examination will be conducted at the Dededo Dental Clinic. Applicants were reminded that they are responsible for providing all necessary clinical instruments, handpieces, gloves, masks, and other examination supplies, while the clinic will provide only the space, lighting and dental chair. The Board advised applicants to coordinate with Dr. Ha before the examination to become familiar with the assigned work area and facility. The Board explained that the second day of the Guam dental licensure examination consists of the operative portion of the examination and requires applicants to provide three patients, which may either be three separate individuals or one patient requiring all three examination procedures. Applicants are required to complete one composite restoration and one amalgam restoration, with the Board emphasizing that careful patient and case selection is essential to ensure that the selected teeth have sound adjacent teeth, proper proximal contacts, and stable occlusion for accurate evaluation. The Board advised applicants to select straightforward lesions of appropriate size that provide sufficient evidence of decay while avoiding excessively large or complex lesions that may increase procedural difficulty or compromise the evaluation. During the discussion, the Board confirmed that both applicants intended to pursue dental licensure and practice in

		Guam. The Board also confirmed each applicant's handedness to ensure appropriate operatory accommodations could be made during the examination. The Board advised applicants that they are responsible for securing their own examination patients and encouraged them to utilize professional contacts, affiliated clinics, and other available resources to identify suitable patients for the operative portion of the examination. The Board further explained that, in addition to the two operative restorative procedures, applicants are required to complete a comprehensive oral diagnosis examination using a patient they provide. Applicants were instructed to select a patient with a multidisciplinary dental case involving multiple areas of treatment rather than a routine preventive or minimally restorative case. The Board explained that applicants will be evaluated on their clinical examination process, including patient assessment, review of radiographs and medical and dental histories, communication with the patient, formulation of diagnoses, and development of a comprehensive written treatment plan. Applicants were also informed that examiners may ask questions regarding their clinical findings and treatment recommendations to assess their clinical reasoning and patient management. The Board emphasized that applicants must provide supporting documentation, including x-rays, medical and dental histories, study models, and a written treatment plan, and noted that the second day of the examination typically concludes at approximately 3:00 p.m. The Board explained that applicants must report on the morning of the second examination day with the completed raw casting of the crown fabricated from the first day's

		laboratory work. The Board will evaluate the raw casting on the typodont to verify its fit before returning the typodont and casting to the applicant for polishing and finishing. Applicants are then required to present a fully finished crown that is ready for cementation, although it will not be cemented, for evaluation of its fit, internal adaptation, proximal contacts, occlusion, and overall quality before proceeding with the remaining clinical examination components. The Board encouraged applicants to seek guidance from dentists who had previously completed the Guam dental licensure examination to better understand the examination process. The Board emphasized that the examination is intended to evaluate fundamental clinical competencies in restorative dentistry, crown preparation, and treatment planning, noting that the procedures are designed to assess routine clinical skills and the applicant's clinical reasoning rather than advanced or specialized techniques. The Board further explained that, following evaluation of the completed crown, applicants may proceed with the operative examination using either one patient requiring both restorative procedures or separate patients for each procedure. Applicants were reminded that the oral diagnosis component should involve a comprehensive multidisciplinary case rather than a routine or minimally restorative patient, as the purpose of the examination is to assess the applicant's patient evaluation process, clinical judgment, treatment planning, and overall approach to patient care. Following completion of the examination, the Board will convene to discuss the examination results. Applicants may

		attend the Board meeting to receive their results directly or may request that the results be mailed to them by providing a current mailing address. The Board invited applicants to raise any additional questions regarding the examination schedule or process. An applicant asked the Board for clarification regarding the allowable age range of patients for the clinical BOR treatment examination and whether there were any age limitations for patient selection. The Board clarified that operative examination patients may be adolescents or adults, provided they have a complete permanent dentition, stable occlusion, and suitable contacts for evaluation. The Board emphasized that patient selection is critical and advised applicants to choose simple, ideal cases with adequate adjacent tooth structure to allow evaluation of proximal contacts and occlusion. The Board noted that lesions selected for operative procedures should be large enough to demonstrate caries extending to or beyond the dentino enamel junction but not so extensive that treatment becomes unnecessarily complicated. Cases that are too small, difficult to evaluate, or otherwise unsuitable may be rejected, and applicants were advised to have appropriate backup patients available. The Board confirmed that the required restorative materials must be used for the designated examination procedures, including amalgam for specified amalgam restorations and composite for designated composite restorations. The Board advised applicants to select straightforward Class II lesions and reminded them that although applicants may have limited

		experience with certain materials, the examination focuses on fundamental restorative procedures. The Board explained that operative preparations will be evaluated in stages. Applicants must first complete the ideal cavity preparation without initially removing additional caries beyond the ideal preparation design. Applicants must then explain any remaining caries or necessary modifications, complete the additional preparation as indicated, and present the final preparation for examiner approval before proceeding with restoration placement. The Board emphasized that applicants should communicate their treatment decisions, including whether additional caries removal, liners, bases, or other procedures are required before restoration. The Board reiterated that rubber dam isolation is required from the beginning of the operative procedure through completion of the restoration. Applicants must place the rubber dam after approval of the selected lesion and have the isolation evaluated before beginning preparation. The Board advised applicants to ensure proper visibility, adequate isolation, and patient comfort. After restoration placement, the rubber dam must be removed before final evaluation so the Board can assess occlusion, proximal contacts, restoration anatomy, and overall quality. The Board encouraged applicants to seek guidance from dentists who have previously completed the Guam dental licensure examination, including individuals familiar with the examination process in Guam and Saipan. The Board noted that previous examinees may provide helpful advice regarding preparation and case selection.

		The Board informed applicants that failure to secure suitable examination patients would require notification to the Board and would result in the applicant needing to retake the full examination during the next scheduled administration. The Board clarified that completion of only portions of the examination would not allow applicants to carry forward completed sections if they were unsuccessful or unable to complete the remaining components. The Board encouraged applicants awaiting licensure to consider employment opportunities as dental auxiliaries, provided they meet Guam licensing requirements and work within the permitted scope of practice. The Board explained that auxiliary practice is limited to reversible procedures and does not include irreversible procedures reserved for licensed dentists. Applicants interested in auxiliary licensure were advised that they must submit the required application documentation, including a practice location or practice plan identifying where they intend to work. The Board further advised applicants to seek opportunities with local dental clinics to maintain clinical skills while awaiting examination results or future examination cycles. The Board reminded applicants to establish a practice plan indicating their intended place of employment, whether practicing under an auxiliary license or after obtaining dental licensure. The Board emphasized that documentation of the planned practice location is required as part of the licensing process.

		The Board confirmed that the Guam dental licensure examination will be held on August 18 and August 19 at the Dededo Dental Clinic, with both examination days beginning at 8:00 a.m. The Board informed applicants that the clinic will provide the space, dental chair, and laboratory facilities, including areas for pouring models, setting stone, locating margins, and completing wax-ups. Applicants were reminded that they are responsible for providing their own instruments, handpieces, personal protective equipment, restorative materials, and other necessary clinical supplies. The Board further reviewed the crown examination process, explaining that applicants will complete their laboratory procedures at the Dededo Dental Clinic following crown preparation, including model preparation, margin identification, waxing, and presentation of the wax-up and casting ring for evaluation. Applicants will retain their laboratory materials after the first examination day to complete the crown fabrication process. On the second examination morning, applicants must present the raw cast crown with the screw attached for evaluation of fit on the typodont. After Board review, materials will be returned to the applicant so the crown can be polished and finished. The applicant must then present a completed crown that is ready for cementation, although it will not be cemented, for evaluation of fit, contacts, occlusion, and overall quality. The Board concluded the discussion by confirming that the applicants had no further questions regarding the examination process.

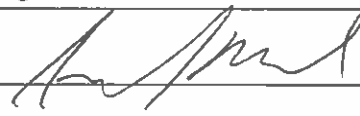

NBA champion player, historic coach Nelson dead at 86

Don Nelson, who won the second-most games of any coach in NBA history and five NBA titles as a player with the Boston Celtics, died on Sunday, his family announced. He was 86.

Nelson was a member of NBA championship teams with Boston from 1966 to 1976 and the Celtics retired his jersey number 19.

As a coach, Nelson finished with a record of 1,335-1,063 — what had been an NBA record until Gregg Popovich passed him in 2022 — in stints with Golden State, Milwaukee, New York and Dallas from 1976 to 2010.

"Don Nelson revolutionized NBA basketball through his fearlessness, ingenuity and deep conviction," NBA commissioner Adam Silver said in a statement.

"He spent nearly 50 years in the NBA -- winning five championships as a player with the Boston Celtics before building one of the most successful and pioneering coaching careers in league history.

"He brought an unmistakable personality to everything he did, and his impact on our sport will

continue to be felt for generations."

Nelson, who was inducted into the Basketball Hall of Fame in 2012, never reached the NBA Finals as a coach but was remembered as a historic figure among bench bosses.

"The Golden State Warriors mourn the passing of Hall of Fame head coach Don Nelson," the team said in a statement.

"Nellie" was one of the most innovative and influential coaches in NBA history and an iconic figure in Warriors history...

"More than anything, Don Nelson will be remembered for his authenticity, larger-than-life personality,

and incredible passion for basketball and his influence on the Warriors franchise will endure for years to come."

Steve Kerr, the current Warriors coach, recalled Nelson as a visionary whose influence remains with the modern era of the league.

"Don Nelson was a true innovator whose influence on the game of basketball is still felt today," Kerr said.

"He consistently challenged conventional thinking, experimented with different lineups and styles of play, and saw possibilities in the game that others often did not.

"So much of what is now commonplace in the modern NBA can be traced back to the way Nellie approached the game."

The Celtics paid tribute to Nelson's playing career in a statement.

"Nellie was a tough and reliable all-around player whose tenacity and ability to 'think the game' was on full display throughout his 11 seasons with the Boston Celtics, where he was a key

member of five championship teams across two eras," the Celtics said.

The Bucks paid tribute to Nelson's first NBA coaching stint.

"During his 11 seasons as Bucks coach from 1976-1987, Nellie won two of his three NBA Coach of the Year awards and established himself as one of the most innovative and visionary leaders in basketball history," the Bucks said.

The Dallas Mavericks called him an innovator and legend whose "impact will never be forgotten," saying he left "an incredible mark on our franchise and the game of basketball."

batting average, 1,088 hits including 98 home runs and drove in 350 runs as well as stealing 122 bases.

Anderson will retire as a member of the White Sox, who will pay tribute to him and other players on September 17.

"I'm getting emotional now because we're talking about something that I worked my whole life to get there," Anderson said.

"Nobody knows what

I sacrificed and what the body felt every day, what I was leaving at home from my kids to my wife, through some of the decisions I made. I still kept going and I had my moments where it bothered me.

"But I couldn't show it and it got to a point where it started showing out loud and I couldn't control it.

"I'm kind of happier, waking up and being able to be around my kids and really living a real life, because life is bigger than trying to make people happier with a bat and a ball."
