V	Chairperson's Report	Chairperson M. Gabriel's report focused entirely on the issue of third-party prescription delivery services, an ongoing topic the board first discussed back in June 2023. She reminded the board that a company called Errand Guam had previously expressed interest in delivering prescription medications to patients, and that Corey Baker, who owns both Errand Guam and a related company, RemedyGU, had met with her the day before this meeting to discuss his delivery service. Baker had been expected to attend the board meeting himself but did not show up. Gabriel noted that the board currently has no specific rules or regulations governing third-party delivery services beyond an existing requirement that medications be delivered directly to the patient's home; she pointed out that Errand Guam's advertising had shown deliveries being made to workplaces, which isn't permitted, and that Baker said he would	GBEP	0804	Noted

Gabriel also walked through the relevant guidance that does exist: HIPAA permits a family member or designated agent to pick up medication on a patient's behalf, and ASHP best practices recommend verifying the identity of anyone picking up medication using two forms of identification, such as date of birth and address. She reiterated other standing pharmacy practices, including that payments cannot be taken over the phone and must be made in person, and that pharmacies should record the name of whoever physically picks up a prescription. This prompted a broader discussion among board members about accountability and risk. Since third-party couriers aren't under contract with the pharmacies themselves and fall outside the board's jurisdiction, members raised concerns about who would be responsible in the event of a misdelivery, how controlled substances or medications requiring refrigeration would be safely handled, and whether couriers understood the confidentiality obligations tied to the sensitive information they'd be handling. There was some discussion clarifying that RemedyGU had previously submitted policies and procedures to the board, though there was uncertainty about the exact filing date and whether they had been properly logged. The board ultimately agreed that Corey Baker (and potentially Aaron Guam representatives) should be invited to attend a future meeting so the board can raise these concerns directly, and that an updated version of the company's policies and procedures should be submitted by email ahead of time to allow the board sufficient time to review them. This topic will be carried over and placed on the agenda for the next board meeting.

quarter tied 0-0. The Cowboys' Jayden Cruz recorded a sack on the third down to force the Eagles to punt.

The Cowboys moved the chains in the first quarter and entered the red zone, looking to score early. The Eagles' got a huge stop in the end zone of an interception by Talan Babauta.

The Cowboys broke the tie in the second period with a 39-yard touchdown pass from quarterback Ezekiel-Rey Maysho to Cruz. Maysho's successful kick put the Cowboys up 8-0. The Eagles responded on the ensuing possession with an 11-yard touchdown run by Kymani Cruz, which was set up by a 38-yard pass from quarterback Talan Babauta to David Sablan.

In the second half, the Cowboys pulled away. Cruz scored his second touchdown of the game on a 12-yard run to extend the lead to 14-6, following a blocked extra-point kick by the Eagles' Sablan. Sablan had a touchdown for 67 yards on their ensuing possession, but the play was called back due to a holding penalty.



The Cowboys capitalized on the momentum, scoring twice in the fourth quarter on touchdowns by Quintanilla and Austin Mesa to secure the 26-6 win.

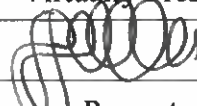
