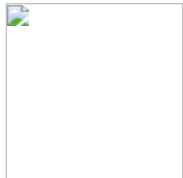

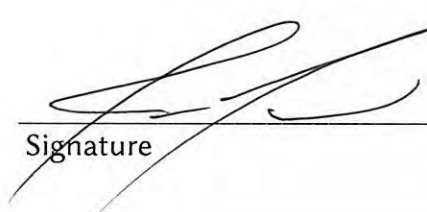

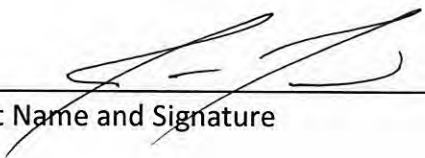

I was able to secure and eventually participate with GPD on the Guam training sites to include the Piti Power Plant and the former hospital site.
