Håfa Adai Mr. Speaker,

Bill 41-38 would transfer over 700 acres of land in Yigo to the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission (GALC). Four lots of land in the *Janom* neighborhood in Yigo, formally owned by the estate of John S.N. Taitano and Rosario F. Taitano. In the 1930s, the land was forfeited to the Naval Government of Guam due to non-payment of property taxes. The Family claims two years later, the land was later redeemed by the Rosario Taitano by paying all taxes plus interest. The redemption has been challenged and the government of Guam has argued the land was transferred to the government of Guam by the Naval government. After almost eighty (80) years of disputed ownership, it is appropriate for the Legislature to finally settle this matter.

As testified by the grandson of John and Rosario, "that land deserves protection, and it is the responsibility of the Taitano family to safeguard our land."

For these reasons, I sign Bill No. 41-38 (COR) into law as **Public Law No. 38-137**.

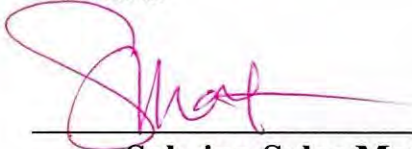

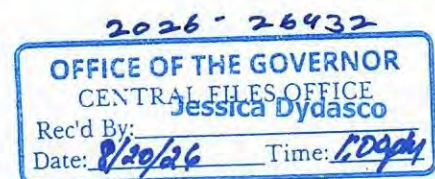

**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 80105(j) TO CHAPTER 80,
TITLE 21, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
TRANSFERRING LOT NOS. 7100, 7102, 7103 AND 7146,
IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF *YIGO*, GUAM, TO THE
GUAM ANCESTRAL LANDS COMMISSION.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new § 80105(j) is hereby *added* to Chapter 80 of Title 21,
Guam Code Annotated, to read:

“(j) Lot Nos. 7100, 7102, 7103 and 7146 claimed by the Estate of
John S.N. Taitano and Rosario F. Taitano in the municipality of *Yigo*. The

1 properties shall be transferred from the Government of Guam and shall be
2 deeded to the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission within thirty (30) days of
3 the effective date of this Act. The Guam Ancestral Lands Commission shall
4 dispose of the land parcel and lot transferred by this Act in a manner consistent
5 with and pursuant to its enabling legislation and its mandates. All pre-
6 condemnation roads, easements and bull cart trails shall remain as easements
7 for public access and utilities.”

8 **Section 2. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
9 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not
10 affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
11 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
12 severable.

13 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
