Håfa Adai Mr. Speaker,

Bill No. 159-38 (COR) removes the requirements applied to other commercial buildings regarding the necessary number of parking spaces for Homeless Shelters. The testimony established that unlike other commercial buildings, whose users are anticipated to arrive by automobile, the people who are likely to frequent the shelters are most likely to arrive and depart on foot. Granting the Department of Public Works the flexibility to establish the necessary number of parking spaces will allow shelters to be established in locations that would not otherwise support them simply because of the need for open ground for parking.

For these reasons, I sign Bill No. 159-38 (COR) into law as **Public Law No. 38-138**.

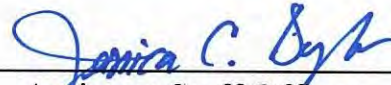

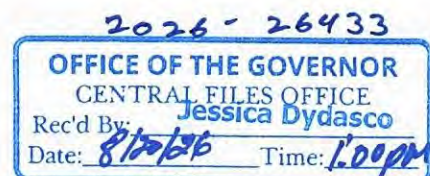

**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 61531(o) TO CHAPTER 61,
TITLE 21, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
GRANTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS
TO DETERMINE THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF
PARKING SPACES REQUIRED FOR HOMELESS
SHELTERS.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new § 61531(o) is *added* to Chapter 61, Title 21, Guam Code
Annotated, to read as follows:

“(o) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Department of
Public Works shall on a case-by-case basis, in permitting the occupancy for
structures to be used exclusively as homeless shelters, determine the minimum

1 number of parking spaces for said homeless shelters, however, the minimum
2 number of spaces for persons with disabilities as required by Public Law, shall
3 not be diminished.”
