focused on the rallies that she lost track of the score.

Zheng is the first qualifier to reach the U.S. Open women's quarter-finals since Emma Raducanu — who went on to win the title — in 2021.

She'll next face world number two Rybakina, the reigning Australian Open champion who cruised past a hurting Naomi Osaka 6-1, 6-4 in just 66 minutes.

Rybakina is not only chasing a third Grand Slam title. If she beats Zheng to reach the semifinals, she will seize the number one ranking from Aryna Sabalenka — even if the Belarusian wins a third straight crown.

"Of course I want it," Rybakina said. "I don't know anyone who wouldn't wish this."

But, she added: "I try to approach the same, fight to the end my next match — let's see what will happen."

Fourth-seeded Coco Gauff reached the quarterfinals for the first time since she won the title in 2023, beating 18-year-old U.S. compatriot Iva Jovic 6-1, 6-4.

Gauff next faces fifth-seeded French Open champion Mirra Andreeva, a 5-7, 6-4, 6-3 winner over Anastasia Potapova.

An injury to Potapova in the final game marred an entertaining contest. When Potapova crashed to the ground lunging for a ball Andreeva rushed to her side. The Russian-born Austrian received treatment on her knee before limping to the finish line.

Alexander Blockx's dream debut continued with a gritty 6-3, 4-6, 7-5, 7-5 victory over Argentina's Francisco Cerundolo, which made the 21-year-old the first Belgian

man to reach the US open last eight.

Blockx, who started the year ranked outside the top 100, said he was "close to retiring" because of sharp pain in an injured rib in the first set.

"Even before the match I was already under medication, and during the match I had medication. So if you feel that much pain while having a lot of medication, that's not a good sign," he said.

Men's top seed Alexander Zverev was once again slated to close the action on Ashe, taking on 21st-seeded Italian Luciano Darderi.

The French Open champion has become a late-night fixture, playing into the small hours not only in two five-set marathons but also in his three-set third round win over Alejandro Tabilo.

The German is vying to make the US Open quarterfinals for a fifth time while Darderi will make the last eight of a Grand Slam for the first time if he can pull off the biggest win of his career.

France's Arthur Gea was vying for a slice of Grand Slam history against Botik van de Zandschulp. He could become the first men's lucky loser ever to reach the quarterfinals at a Grand Slam.

Guam's Flores brings home Gold & Silver from OCR World Championships in China

Less than a month after winning a silver medal in Ireland, American Ninja Warrior athlete, Rai "King Rai" Flores, won gold and silver medals at the International Modern Pentathlon Union Obstacle Course Racing World Championships Sept. 2-6 in Beijing, China.

The Guam Modern Pentathlon Federation and Guam Ninja Association made the announcement in a joint press release.

The Beijing event brings together some of the best Ninja, Obstacle Course Racing, and Pentathlon athletes from throughout

Flores was also selected to run the 3000 meter team event as a member of Team Oceania with athletes from New Zealand. Reflecting on his experience in Beijing, Flores said "I love representing Guam and had a spectacular time throughout this competition. Teaming up with elite athletes who have become friends from around the world was so much fun and I can't wait to see them again!"

the world to compete in 100 meter, 400 meter, and 3000 meter obstacle course races as well as 4 X 100 meter and 3000 meter obstacle course team events, according to the release.

In a hard fought battle, Flores earned a silver medal in the male U19 400 meter obstacle course race, missing

the gold medal by less than a second to Hleb Rolia from Belarus. During the qualifying round, Flores slipped in the middle of his first race, falling behind by 20 meters and had to sprint to catch the athlete from Israel in a thrilling finish that secured his place in the championship round.

Flores was selected to run the anchor leg for Team Oceania in the 4 X 100 meter mixed team relay alongside 3 athletes from Australia, securing a gold medal over the team from China. In a gesture of good will, Flores' Australian teammates opted to have the Guam flag displayed to
