June Aflague

Staff training reports from employees – Yvonne Flores (PC), Jane Dorion (LT), Bryan Pacheco (LT), Linda Aguon (LT), and Florence Taitague (Supervisor). These training took place from Sept – Nov 2024

Staff training will begin in February on Fridays and training at the Joeten-Kiyu Public Library for Bookmobile operations and archival.

Update on Grants:

In the FY2023 IMLS project and procurement plan has been updated to reflect all purchase orders received. As of 10/2024, and with an extension grant from IMLS, FY2024 closed with remaining monies left at \$96,630. We had to either use up these monies or run the risk of returning it to IMLS. As of 12/30/24, I am pleased to report we are in receipt of all purchase orders for all the requisitions submitted to GSA, and after closing out the Pos, the estimated amount we anticipate returning is down to \$12,573. Final reporting to IMLS is by 04/30/2025. 80% of book purchases are to replace the adult collection due to the loss of books on the 2nd floor.

MARISSA MEARS

JUNE AFLAGUE

There have been no books ordered for the past three years. Neither Jenelle nor I were given any book orders to submit. Additionally, regarding E-books, the purchase order was \$130,000, and GPLS ended up returning \$60,000. A new funding source to bring back the E-books is the FY2025 funding cycle from IMLS.

JENELLE CRUZ

E-books were funded under the DOI TAP Grant which is for a 3-year period. During that 3-yr period, the department should have been aggressively looking for an alternate source of funding to sustain it, but that was not done.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) establishes a sponsorship agreement between Guam Education Telecommunication Corporation, operating as PBS Guam – KGTF Channel 12, hereafter referred to as “PBS Guam,” located at PO Box 21449 GMF Barrigada, Guam 96921, and the Guam Public Library System, hereafter referred to as “Sponsor,” situated at 254 Martyr Street, Hagatna, GU 96910. This agreement pertains to the PBS KIDS Super Hero Sponsorship, hereafter referred to as the “Program.” The purpose of this MOU is to formalize the mutual responsibilities and commitments associated with this agreement as outlined below:

F. Sponsor agrees to pay PBS Guam, in receipt of invoice the sum of \$12,000.00 to PBS Guam – KGTF Channel 12

G. Sponsor shall provide PBS Guam a company approved high resolution logo image (in jpeg, eps or ai) to be used for all promotional materials and on pbsguam.org.

H. Sponsor shall provide informational content (i.e. photos) to be used as extra footage for the :30 video spot (if applicable).

III. CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTION

A. The above stated sum is a charitable contribution to PBS Guam and therefore is tax deductible under section 170 of the Internal Revenue Code, provisions of Sections 2055, 2106 and 2522. However, PBS Guam cannot warrant Sponsor's eligibility for such deduction or the amount thereof.

IV. PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION

A. Full payment must be received by PBS Guam to secure the Sponsorship, unless otherwise arranged in writing. All requests for cancellation of a Sponsorship must be submitted in writing. All paid and guaranteed Sponsorships canceled in writing (as set forth in the Terms and Conditions) at least sixty (60) days in advance of the Program will receive a fifty percent (50%) refund of the total Sponsorship fee. All underwriting, video production and airtime will be canceled. No refunds or credits will be issued on cancellation requests received less than Sixty (60) days prior to the scheduled Program. Sponsorships are non-transferable.

V. TERM

A. The term of the Sponsorship Agreement shall commence on the date hereof and shall continue in full force and effect until the conclusion of the Program or the last day of the Underwriting schedule.

VI. INDEMNIFICATION

A. Sponsor agrees to indemnify and hold PBS Guam, the program facility and its owners, officers, committees, directors, employees and agents (collectively, the "Indemnities") harmless from any and all claims, damages, costs, losses, expenses, causes of action, liabilities and obligations of whatever nature or type, which the Sponsor has, or may have, or which have been, or could have been, or in the future otherwise might have asserted against it in connection with acts of the Sponsor, its directors, shareholders, officers, agents or employees. Upon signing this Agreement, Sponsor expressly releases the Indemnities from any and all claims for loss, damage or injury.

VII. ATTORNEY'S FEES



KGTF CHANNEL 12 Guam Educational Telecommunication Corporation

A. In the event that either party to this MOU shall commence any legal action or proceeding to enforce or interpret the provisions of this MOU, the prevailing party in the action proceeding shall be entitled to recover its costs of suit, including reasonable attorneys fees.

VIII. AMENDMENTS AND TIME

A. Any changes, supplements and/or amendments will not be made to this agreement without the written consent of both parties. Time is of the essence in respect to all provisions of this MOU that specify a time for performance.

IX. GOVERNING LAW

A. All agreements herein are subject to, and will be carried out in compliance with, all applicable federal and Guam laws, regulations and other legal requirements.

As you know, the Governor transmitted the FY 2026 Executive Budget to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* on January 31st, 2025. It includes revenue projections, funding allocations to the various departments/agencies, and other funding requirements. Accordingly, your ceiling level by fund source is part of the Governor's submittal.

Delineated below is your department/agency ceiling level by fund source, as may be annotated. Please prepare your FY 2026 Budget Request based on each ceiling amount using the format and guidelines provided by the Bureau per BBMR Circular No. 25-03 dated December 4, 2024. Additionally, please ensure that your FY 2025 Current and FY 2026 Proposed Staffing Patterns factor in the new salary levels for employees under the 2023 General Pay Plan. Use the government rate of contribution to the Retirement Fund of 34.80%. Additionally, for Vacant / Funded positions (if any), departments are to use the following insurance rates: Medical HSA 2000 Class 2: \$8,310 / Dental Class 2: \$486. Each ceiling amount is for operational requirements, inclusive of local match requirements for federal programs:

General Fund:	\$ 0
Special Fund:	\$ 1,932,072 ^{1/}

Recurring or routine miscellaneous appropriations should not be included in your agency detail budget request, as such appropriations are not part of the budget ceiling level(s).

The Bureau emphasizes the importance of following the guidelines provided in order to facilitate the budget process. It is imperative that we work together to produce a complete and accurate budget within the prescribed timeframe.

Please submit one (1) *original* Department budget request and one (1) CD or USB flash drive with copies of the electronic files (Excel for spreadsheets and Word for narratives). Upon review and clearance by the Bureau, you will be notified to reproduce the required number of copies for transmittal to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* for their disposition.

Your department/agency budget request is due to the Bureau no later than **Monday, February 10, 2025**. This deadline must be met to ensure timely submittal to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. Your usual cooperation is appreciated.

Good morning Abigail,

Below is a question from our library board chair, and I did forget to inquire that with you yesterday:

Regarding the prior year Library Resource Fund appropriations, this is from the FY23 budget act. If DOE hasn't processed any encumbrances/expenditures from the 30% appropriated to GPLS, it should still be available as it doesn't lapse. It seems that with Section 41, DOE can transfer \$200,000 to GPLS but I'm not sure if that can be done now that FY23 has ended. Would it be best to check with BBMR?
