Håfa Adai Mr. Speaker,

For the reasons provided below, Bill No.81-38 (COR) will lapse into law without my signature. My administration supports this legislation's general intent of removing the electrical system knowledge requirement for photovoltaic electrical systems from the Solar HVAC contractor licensing requirements. However, as this administration has noted many times before, enacting regulations through the legislative process violates the separation of powers doctrine, which prohibits legislation that amends executive rules and regulations, just as it prohibits an agency from amending legislative enactments. The amendment to the regulations concerning licensing requirements for a solar HVAC contractor's license should have been accomplished through the formal rulemaking process found in the Administrative Adjudication Law by the Contractor's Licensing Board. Under the separation of powers doctrine, each branch of government must operate in distinct, clearly defined spheres. The Organic Act of Guam charges the Executive Branch with powers to issue "regulations" not in conflict with any applicable law, including Guam's rulemaking laws.

Conversely, the Legislature is charged with drafting and passing "bills." Rulemaking and law-making are separate and distinct roles as provided by the Organic Act of Guam. Bill No. 81-38's proposed amendments to Guam's Administrative Rules and Regulations infringe on well-established principles. While it is within the Legislature's authority to pass a bill containing the provisions in Bill No. 81-38's, once the Legislature delegates rulemaking authority to an agency, as it has with the Contractor's Licensing Board, it must honor such delegation and not interfere with agency rulemaking unless the agency's rulemaking power is otherwise rescinded.

AN ACT TO AMEND § 12401(d)C-53, ARTICLE 4, CHAPTER 12, TITLE 25, GUAM ADMINISTRATIVE RULES AND REGULATIONS, RELATIVE TO CORRECTING THE DEFINITIONS OF SOLAR HVAC CONTRACTORS SUB-CLASSIFICATIONS OF LICENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that among qualifications for a Solar HVAC (heating, ventilation and air
- 4 conditioning) contractor are the same qualifications as those who install photovoltaic

- 1 electrical solar systems. These contractors, however, do not as part of the HVAC
- 2 license, install electrical systems. Appliances such, as solar waters heaters, use the
- 3 heat from the sun to heat water. There is a separate and distinct license for contractors
- 4 that install solar panels which collect electrical energy from photons produced by
- 5 sunlight and convert the energy from direct current (DC) to alternating current (AC)
- 6 through an inverter.
- 7 It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to remove the electrical system
- 8 knowledge requirements for photovoltaic electrical systems from the Solar HVAC
