Bill No. 75-38 (COR) allows members of the United States Armed Forces on active duty in Guam, as well as their dependents, who possess a valid operator's license from any state, territory, or commonwealth, to operate vehicles without obtaining a local license. Bill 75 essentially eliminates unnecessary administrative obstacles and shows our support for our military community. This legislation reflects our commitment to ensuring that service members and their families can focus on their duties without the added burden of additional licensing requirements.

For these reasons, I sign Bill No. 75-38 (COR) into law as **Public Law No. 38-22**.



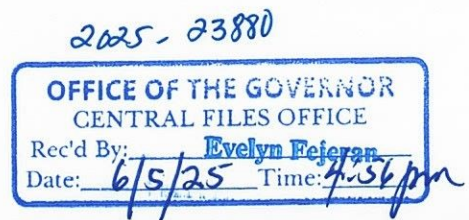

**AN ACT TO AMEND § 3101(b) OF CHAPTER 3, TITLE 16,
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
EXEMPTING ACTIVE-DUTY SERVICE MEMBERS
AND THEIR DEPENDENTS FROM DRIVER'S
LICENSING REQUIREMENTS.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** § 3101(b) of Chapter 3, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, is
3 hereby *amended* to read:

1 “(b)(1) A person who is a member of the United States Armed Forces
2 on active duty on Guam, having in their immediate possession a valid
3 operator’s license issued by any other territory, commonwealth, or state of the
4 United States, need not obtain an operator’s license or license with similar
5 endorsement.

6 (2) The dependent of a person who is a member of the United States
7 Armed Forces on active duty in Guam, having in their immediate possession
8 a valid operator’s license issued by any other territory, commonwealth, or
9 state of the United States, need not obtain an operator’s license or a license
10 with a similar endorsement.

11 **Section 2. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
12 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not
13 affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
14 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
15 severable.

16 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
