**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 1909(c) OF CHAPTER 19, TITLE
1, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE
DUTIES OF THE PUBLIC AUDITOR.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** § 1909(c) of Chapter 19, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, is
3 hereby *amended* to read:

4 “(c) To communicate directly with any person or with any
5 department, officer or person having official relations with the office in any
6 matter relating to the expenditures of government funds and property or to the
7 settlement thereof; and

8 (1) establish deadlines for submission by every department or
9 agency head, inclusive of autonomous entities, or head of a program
10 within the government of Guam of all financial or program information
11 under their control as are necessary to carry out the duties and functions
12 of the Office of Public Accountability. Failure to submit such

1 information by the required deadline shall result in the imposition of a
2 Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) fine against the general manager,
3 director, or head of the agency, in their personal capacity, per missed
4 deadline which shall be deposited into the Guam Memorial Hospital
5 Operations Fund. An additional fine of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars
6 (\$250.00) shall be assessed against the general manager, director, or
7 head of the agency, in their personal capacity, for every thirty (30) days
8 that the reporting requirements are not met.

9 (2) The Public Auditor shall file a report of those general
10 managers, directors, or heads of the agency who fail to pay the fine
11 imposed herein within thirty (30) days with the Office of the Attorney
12 General of Guam for enforcement.”

13 (3) Deadline Extension.

14 (a) Notwithstanding the deadlines set forth within this
15 Act, an agency director who is unable to comply with the
16 submission deadline specified herein may submit a written
17 request to the Office of Public Accountability (OPA) for an
18 extension at least five (5) days prior to the established deadline.
19 The request must clearly specify the reasons for noncompliance
20 and propose an alternative submission date.

21 (b) Upon receipt of the request, the OPA shall issue a
22 written decision within three (3) business days. Should the OPA
23 grant the extension, the decision shall clearly indicate the revised
24 deadline. If the extension is denied, the written decision shall
25 specify the reasons for denial and must be transmitted to *I*
26 *Maga'hågan/Maga'låhen Guåhan* and the Speaker of *I*
27 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* within forty-eight (48) hours of issuance.”
