**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 25.25 OF CHAPTER 25, TITLE 9,  
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ADDING  
STRONGER PENALTIES FOR CRIMES OF THIRD  
DEGREE CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT  
COMMITTED AGAINST YOUNGER VICTIMS.**

1           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2           **Section 1.**   § 25.25 of Chapter 25, Title 9, Guam Code Annotated, is  
3           *amended* to read as follows:

4           “§ 25.25.   **Third Degree Criminal Sexual Conduct.**

1           (a) A person is guilty of criminal sexual conduct in the third degree  
2 if the person engages in sexual penetration with another person, and if any of  
3 the following circumstances exists:

4           (1) that other person is at least fourteen (14) years of age  
5 and under sixteen (16) years of age;

6           (2) force or coercion is used to accomplish the sexual  
7 penetration; and

8           (3) the actor knows or has reason to know that the victim  
9 is mentally impaired, mentally incapacitated, or physically helpless.

10          (b) Criminal sexual conduct in the third degree is a felony of the  
11 second degree except as provided in (c).

12          (c) Aggravated Third Degree Criminal Sexual Conduct. A person  
13 who is eighteen (18) years of age or older, who commits criminal sexual  
14 conduct in the third degree pursuant to § 25.25(a)(1) of this Chapter against  
15 a victim who is at least (14) years of age and under sixteen (16) years of  
16 age, and where the act involved any of the following circumstances:  
17 (1) the use of force or coercion; (2) the actor is more than five (5) years older  
18 than the victim; (3) the actor occupies a position of authority or supervision  
19 over the victim; or (4) the actor has a prior conviction for criminal sexual  
20 conduct, shall be guilty of a felony of the first degree and shall be sentenced to  
21 a term of confinement of not less than Twelve (12) years and no more than  
22 twenty-five (25) years. The term imposed shall not be suspended; nor  
23 shall probation be imposed in lieu of said term, as indicated in § 80.60 of  
24 Article 4, Chapter 80, Title 9 GCA; nor shall parole, work release, or  
25 educational programs outside the confines of prison be granted. The  
26 provisions of § 80.39.1, the Justice Safety Valve, shall not apply.

27          (d) Close-in-Age Mitigation.

1           Notwithstanding subsection (c), if the victim is fourteen (14) or fifteen  
2 (15) and the offender was not more than (4) years older than the victim, and  
3 the act was consensual as defined in § 25.10(a)(2), the offense shall remain a  
4 felony of the second degree, and the offender shall not be required to register  
5 under the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act pursuant to §  
6 89.01(d)(8).

7           (e) Any person previously convicted of criminal sexual conduct  
8 under § 25.25(a) subsequent to a first conviction of criminal sexual conduct  
9 under Guam law or a conviction of a sex offense from another jurisdiction  
10 that has an element that would constitute sexual contact or sexual  
11 penetration as defined in § 25.10 of this Chapter shall be sentenced to  
12 ten (10) years imprisonment without the possibility of parole. Said term shall  
13 not be suspended; nor probation be imposed in lieu of said term, as indicated  
14 in § 80.60 of Article 4, Chapter 80, Title 9 GCA; nor shall parole, work  
15 release or educational programs outside the confines of prison be granted.”
